



Transfer Guide: MCC Criminal Justice Transfer (CJTAS) to UNO Bachelor of Science in Criminology & Criminal Justice (2024)

The Criminal Justice Transfer degree is intended for students planning to continue their education at a four-year college or university with the goal of obtaining their bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice. This degree is designed to give students a strong foundation in the three-component criminal justice system; police, courts, and corrections.
