### **Additional Information for Students:**

Per UNO's Catalog and University Transfer Credit Policy, sixty-four (64) semester credit hours is the maximum allowed to transfer to most undergraduate UNO colleges from regionally accredited two-year colleges.

To maximize credit transfer, students are strictly encouraged to follow this Guided Pathway. When followed correctly, students will have approximately (56) Credit/Semester Hours remaining to complete for the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration.
